John 15:9-17 (Common English Bible)

Love each other

9 "As the Father loved me, I too have loved you. Remain in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. 11 I have said these things to you so that my joy will be in you and your joy will be complete. 12 This is my commandment: love each other just as I have loved you. 13 No one has greater love than to give up one's life for one's friends. 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you. 15 I don't call you servants any longer, because servants don't know what their master is doing. Instead, I call you friends, because everything I heard from my Father I have made known to you. 16 You didn't choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you could go and produce fruit and so that your fruit could last. As a result, whatever you ask the Father in my name, he will give you. 17 I give you these commandments so that you can love each other."

Conversation and Connection

Instead of a formal sermon today we will spend the next 30 minutes getting to know one another. Please bring your paper with you as you share with each other.

Conversation Round 1

- 1. What place feels most like home? What do you love about it?
- 2. How did you get connected to this faith community? What is one of your favorite memories here?
- 3. What is one thing that the pandemic brought into your life that you would like to keep or hold onto?
- 4. What is a hope you have for yourself in the coming year? For your family? For the church? For this city/town?

Conversation Round 2

- 1. What brings you joy these days?
- 2. What weighs heavy on you, or causes you grief?
- 3. What is something you have learned about yourself in the past year?
- 4. If you could go back in time and teach your younger self one lesson, what would it be?

Conversation Round 3

- 1. What's your favorite family tradition? Or, what's a tradition you want to start and pass along to
- 2. those you love?
- 3. We often talk about "mountain top" experiences in our faith—places where God feels close.
- 4. Where is a place that you have felt close to God? What was holy about it?
- 5. Share a key moment in your faith journey. How did that moment shape what you believe today?
- 6. Who is someone who has been influential in your faith? What impact did they have?

Conversation Round 4

- 1. Is there a story behind your given name or your surname? If you have a nickname or a chosen name, how is this name meaningful to you?
- 2. Share a memory related to food—a family recipe, a baking ritual, or a time of breaking bread with loved ones.
- 3. What is your first memory of grief? What have you learned from your grief?
- 4. Share a story of a time when you felt the most like yourself.
